We are asking that students not be sent with microwavable items moving forward. We encourage parents to pack warm items in a thermos as students will not have access to the microwave in the multipurpose room.

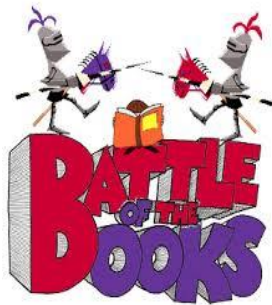
